This letter serves as legal notice of the termination of your tenancy at the above referenced address and at the above stated time and date pursuant to Paragraph 10 of your TAA Lease Agreement. You are legally required to vacate the premises on or before December 31, 2014.

It has been a pleasure to host your tenancy at Highland Terrace Apartments, but the community is being redeveloped which demands that your building be vacated. The following information may be of assistance to you in this transition:
